Bike Recycling

Bikes in all states of disrepair can be taken to the Street Maintenance Division building, 1120 Haskell Ave, from 7:30a.m. until 4:00p.m. to be refurbished and redistributed.

Tree trimmings, limbs and branches can be self-hauled on Saturdays: from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 10 through mid-November. Fee: \$3.00 fee per vehicle.

Trash Pick Up,

Bag small items before putting them out for collection. Sawdust, cat litter, sweeping compounds, shredded paper, facial tissues, packaging materials, etc., all blow in the breeze when containers are emptied by the collectors.

If you don't drop off branches for recycling, bundle and place with trash. Bundles should not exceed 5 feet in length, 18 inches in diameter, or 65 pounds per bundle.

Need soil condition with nutrients and organic matter?

Add biosolids to gardens, flowers, and any landscaping at no charge. Pick up daily at the City of Lawrence Wastewater Treatment Plant -11th Street entrance (2 blocks east of 11th and Haskell) Questions or directions, call 832-7846.
