City of Lawrence Ordinance 7738 requires youth, 15 years old and younger, to properly wear an approved skate or bike helmet securely fastened by chin or neck strap when riding a bike, roller skates, inline skates, roller blades, skateboards, or scooter.

Youth not wearing a helmet are eligible to receive a coupon valid for a **free bicycle helmet** redeemable at a Lawrence Douglas County Fire Medical station.
