Dear CMB Retailer or Packaged Liquor Retailer,

As you may know the State of Kansas changed State liquor laws concerning Sunday and certain Holiday sales. The attached memorandum explains these changes or you may review 2005 Senate Bill 298. On June 28, 2005, the City Commission requested that CMB retailers and Packaged Liquor Retailers express its opinion on whether the City Commission should adopt an ordinance allowing for Sunday and certain Holiday sales. **Changes in State law provide that the City must allow both Sunday sales of packaged liquor and Sunday sales of cereal malt beverages if Sunday sales are to be approved. The City cannot allow just CMB only or Liquor sales only.** We are requesting that you indicate your interests and concerns below and return this information to David Corliss, Assistant City Manager, P.O. ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUNDAY SALES OF ALCHOLIC
LIQUOR AND CEREAL MALT BEVEAGE IN THE ORIGINAL
PACKAGE WITHIN THE CITY OF _____

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
_____:

Section 1. Pursuant to the 2005 Kan. Sess. Laws, Ch.201, the sale of retail of cereal malt beverage in the original package is allowed within the city on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 pm.

Section 2. Pursuant to 2005 Kan. Sess. Laws, Ch. 201, the sale at retail of Alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the city on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 pm., and on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication or on November 15, 2005, whichever is later, unless a sufficient Petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided in 2005 Kan. Sess. Laws, Ch. 201, in which case this ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
