What's happening?

To serve a growing population and maintain the community's quality of life, the City of Lawrence is planning for the construction of a water reclamation facility along the Wakarusa River, south of Lawrence. The 2003 Wastewater Master Plan (www.lawrenceutilities.com) recommended a second treatment facility that will discharge into the Wakarusa River.
