NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION TAX REBATE INITIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

You must answer "yes" to each of the following questions in order to submit a Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Rebate Application

- 1. Are you the owner of the property?
- 2. Is the property in the Neighborhood Revitalization Area?
- 3. Are the taxes on the property current?
- 4. Will the planned improvement comply with the Zoning Ordinances and all applicable codes?



APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- 1. The applicant should obtain an Application for the Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Rebate Incentive Program from the Building Inspections Division concurrent with obtaining a building permit application. However, if the building permit has already been obtained, the applicant should request an application from the Community Development Division.
- 2. The applicant shall complete and sign Part I of the original application and submit it along with a copy of the building permit to: Community Development Division, Attention: Helen Marie Fotovich, 701 North 7th Street, Room 823, Kansas City, KS 66101.
- 3. Prior to December 1, following commencement of construction and each succeeding December 1 until and including the year of project completion, the applicant shall complete and sign a new copy of Part 2, Section A of the Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Rebate Incentive Program application, indicating the anticipated status of the project as of the following January 1. The applicant must submit Part 2, Section B of the application to the Appraiser's Office for valuation consideration.
- 4. On or before January 1, the County appraiser shall conduct an on-site inspection, review the construction records and determine the new valuation of the real estate, and shall complete Part 2, Section B, of the application and submit the report of the new valuation, along with the revised tax information, by June 1 to the Division of Community Development.
- 5. Upon determination that the status of the improvements as of January 1 meets the eligibility criteria, the Appraiser's Office shall so certify to the Unified Government Clerk that the project and application meet the requirements for a tax rebate and shall notify the Division of Community Development and the Finance Department that the applicant qualifies for the tax rebate.
- 6. Upon the payment of the real estate tax for the subject property for the initial and each succeeding tax year extending through the specified rebate period, and within a thirty (30) day period following the date of tax distribution by the Unified Government to the other taxing units, a tax rebate, less the appropriate administrative fee, shall be made to the applicant. The tax rebate shall be made by the Unified Government Treasurer from the Neighborhood Revitalization Fund established in conjunction with the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City Kansas and the other taxing units participating in an Inter-local Agreement.
- 7. The Appraiser's Office shall inform the Unified Government Clerk, the Division of Community Development, and Finance Department thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the final rebate period for each property receiving a tax rebate.
