ORDINANCE NO. <u>0 - 103 - 99</u>

AN ORDINANCE

to adopt a revised Neighborhood Revitalization Plan and to designate a Neighborhood Revitalization Area as provided by K.S.A. 12-17,114 et seq.; and to repeal Ordinance No. 0-94-98 and the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan adopted thereby.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE UNIFIED GOVERNMENT OF WYANDOTTE COUNTY/KANSAS CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1. The governing body of the Unified Government of Wyandotte County/Kansas City, Kansas conducted a public hearing on December 30, 1999, as required by K.S.A. 12-17,117(c), to hear and consider public comment regarding the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Neighborhood Revitalization Plan. The Commission, after said public hearing, hereby adopts the attached Neighborhood Revitalization Plan as provided by K.S.A. 12-17,117.

Section 3. <u>Designation of Neighborhood Revitalization Area.</u> Pursuant to K.S.A. 12-17,116, the Commission hereby designates a Neighborhood Revitalization Area and finds that said area contains:

- 1. A predominance of buildings or premise which by reason of dilapidation, deterioration, or obsolescence are detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare;
- 2. A substantial number of deteriorated or deteriorating structures, incompatible land use relationships, faulty lot layout in relation to size, adequacy, accessibility or usefulness, or a combination of such factors which substantially impairs or arrests sound growth, retards provision of housing or constitutes an economic or social liability and which is detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare; or
- 3. A predominance of buildings which are significant by reason of age, history or architecture which should be preserved or restored to productive use.

The Commission hereby designates the real property described in the attached Neighborhood Revitalization Plan as a Neighborhood Revitalization Area.

Section 4. Neighborhood Revitalization Fund. The Commission does hereby create a Neighborhood Revitalization Fund as provided by K.S.A. 12-17,118, to finance the redevelopment of the Revitalization Area and to provide a rebate of the property tax increment as set forth in the attached Neighborhood Revitalization Plan.

Section 5. Repeal of prior Neighborhood Revitalization Plan. The Commission does hereby repeal Ordinance No. 0-94-98 dated October 22, 1998, and the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan adopted thereby.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Kansas City Kansan.
