David,

On behalf of Lawrence Memorial Hospital I would like update you on the routing of the primary power conductors associated with the LMH Expansion.

Lawrence Memorial Hospital is willing to pursue the route from 4th Street North along the abandoned Alabama St. right of way to 3rd St. then west along 3rd to the West side of Maine then North to the NE corner of the LMH campus. LMH will bare the cost of the Alabama routing pending the approval of the City of Lawrence and adjacent residents within a finite timeframe. Due to schedule constraints, we would propose a timeframe of 2 weeks from the date of notification of the Pinckney Neighborhood Association, residents of the 300 Block of Maine and residents immediately adjacent to the proposed routing.

Should we not obtain that approval within the specified timeframe, then we would propose routing down Maine Street from 4th to the NE corner of the LMH campus, with a hybrid route of the East and West side that would minimize the impact on existing trees.

Most importantly the large Pin Oaks on the East and West sides would be spared and at the most some of the smaller ornamental trees and the smaller trees on the west side may require some trimming or worst case, removal of a couple of the trees furthest to the north on the East side.
