To the Department of Neighborhood Resources:

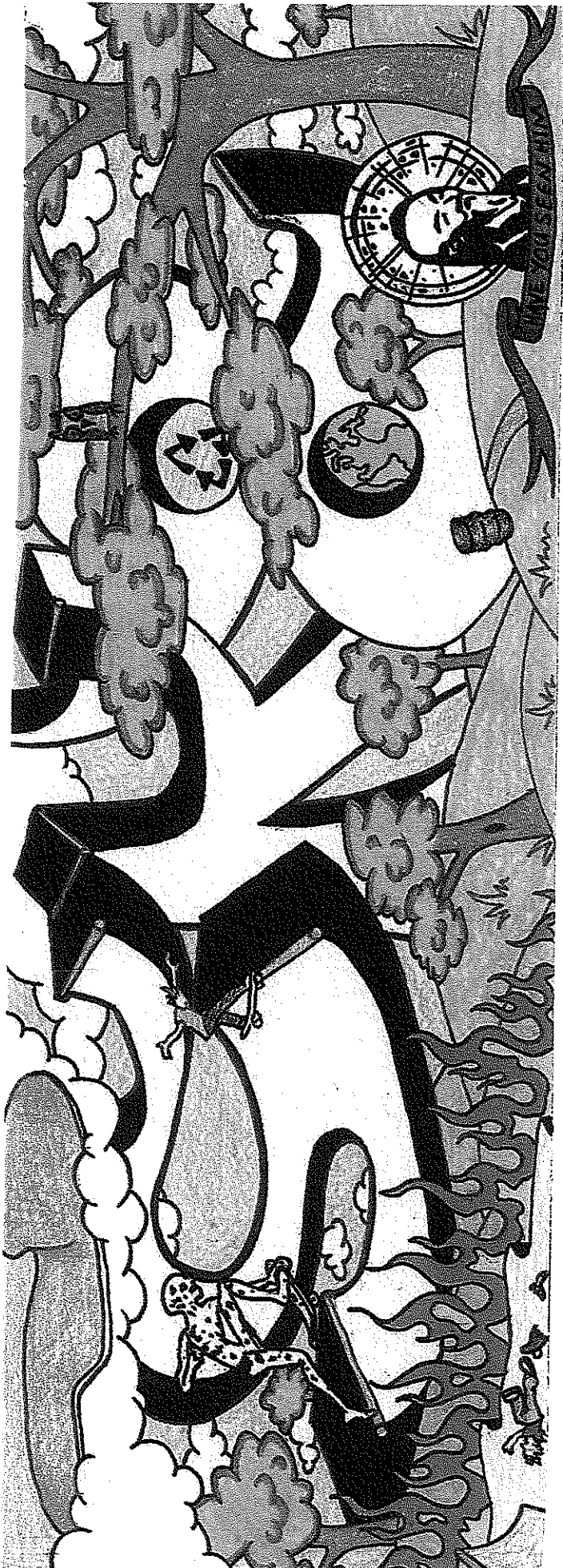
