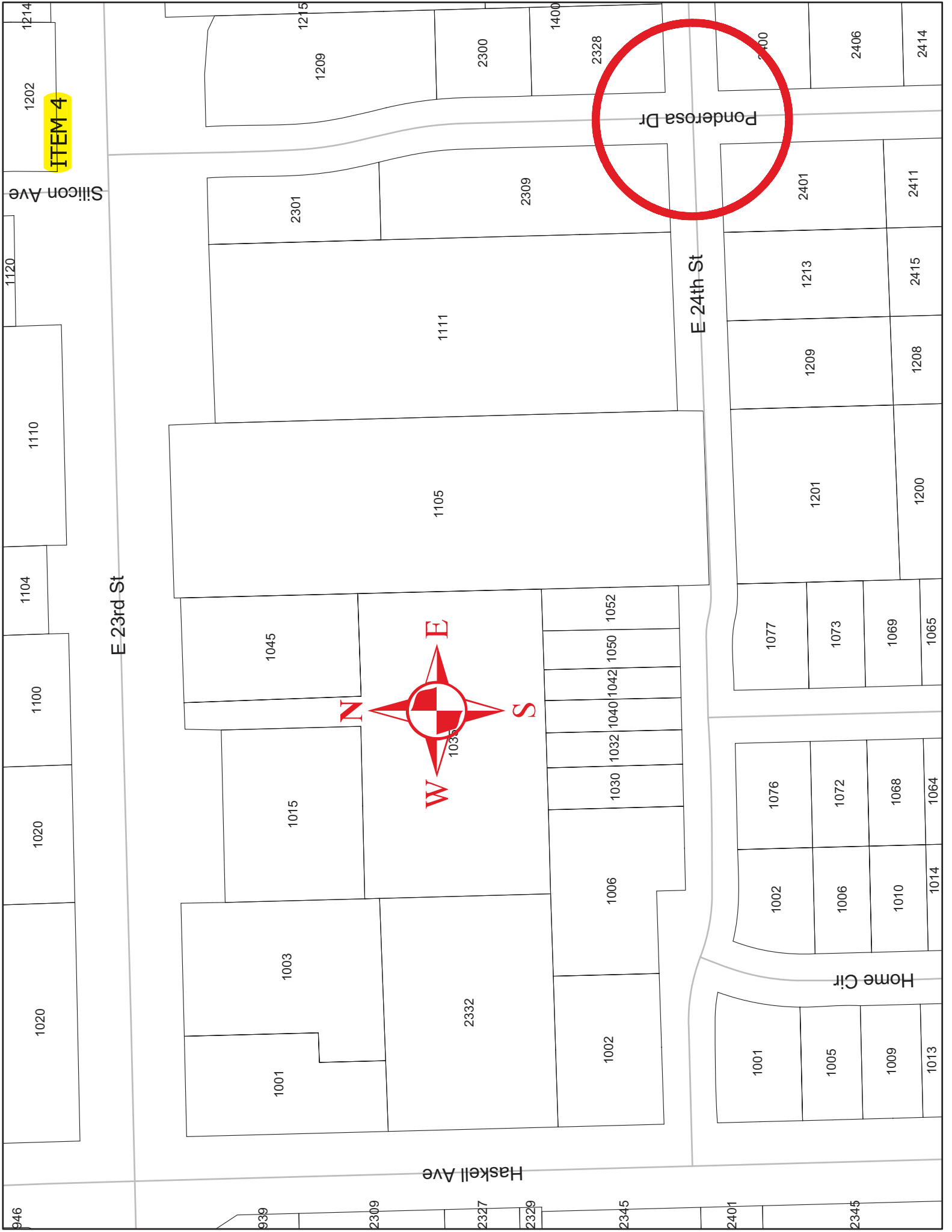

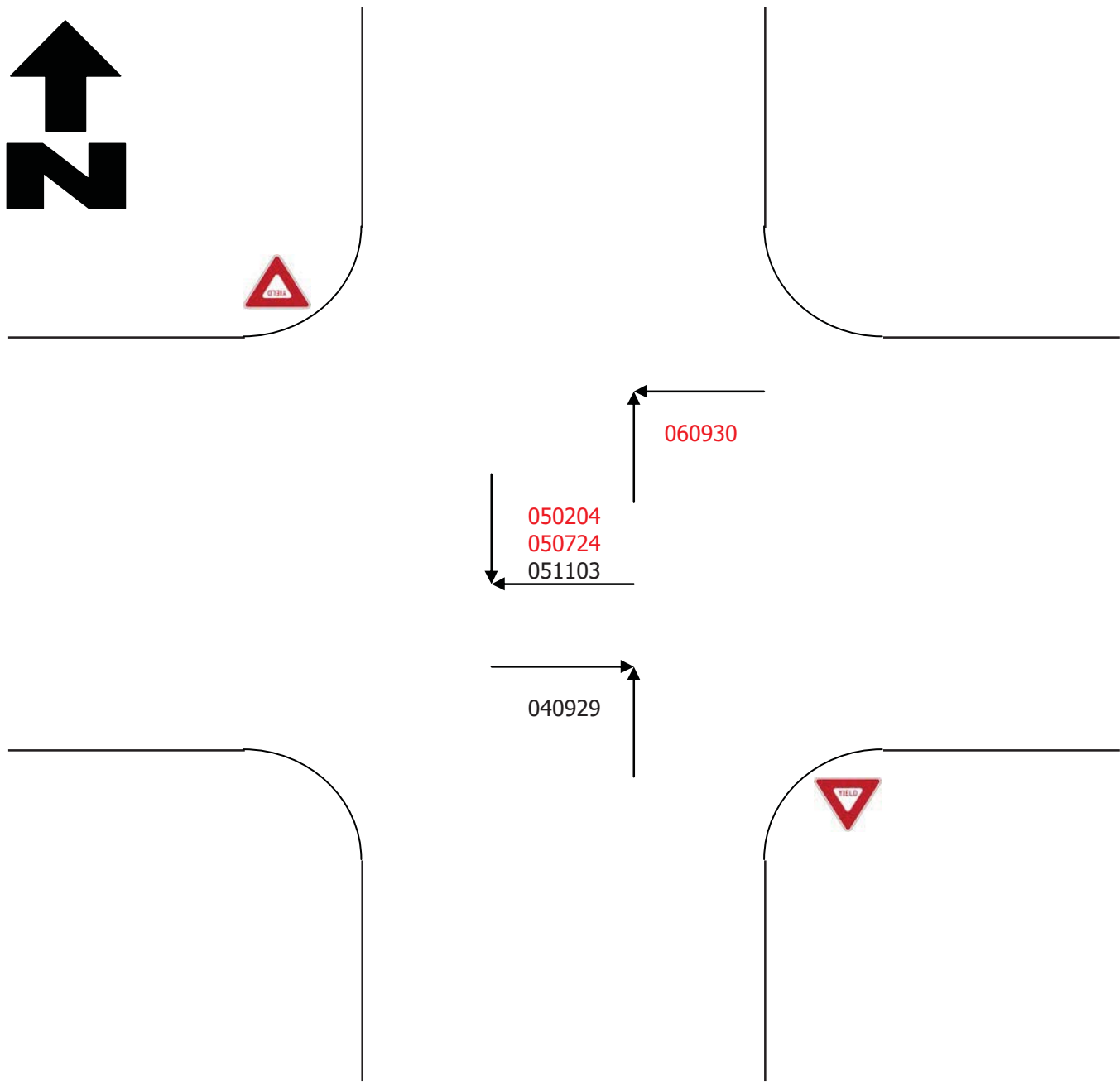


City of Lawrence, Kansas
