Lawrence Municipal Airport AIP No. 3-20-0047-14 Gas Line – Magellan Agreement

Missouri, Nebraska

The subject reimbursement agreement with Magellan Pipeline is acceptable for use on the subject AIP funded project. This agreement provides for the following;

"Relocate approximately 250' of existing gas line to accommodate improvements to the runway safety area"

This approval is based on the compensation of actual costs for Magellan's services not exceeding \$155,400. Please provide advance coordination if the actual costs appear to exceed this value. Please ensure that invoices for this work show sufficient detailed information of the actual costs incurred by Magellan.

Be advised that FAA policy for utilities installed on airport property requires that utility rights be subordinated to the airport owner for the purpose of protecting uninterrupted operation of the airport. We trust that your existing lease agreement with Magellan adequately protects normal operation of the airport unless formal approval is obtained.
