

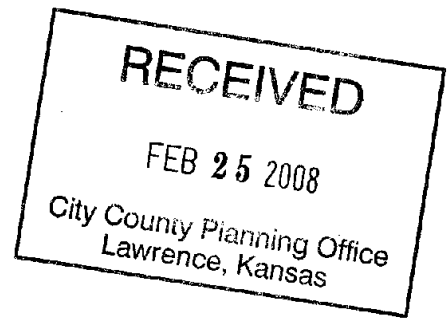

The National Park Service has reviewed the revised plans and specifications submitted via e-mail on December 31, 2007, regarding the Carnegie Library, prepared under Save America's Treasures grant, number **20-04-ML-0021**. These documents concerned a revised drawing (dated January 23, 2007) for the proposed new addition. The new addition is acceptable as it is low in height than the parapet and rear roof level of the original historic building. NPS has discussed this addition with the Kansas State Historic Preservation Office and they also have found it to be acceptable.
