



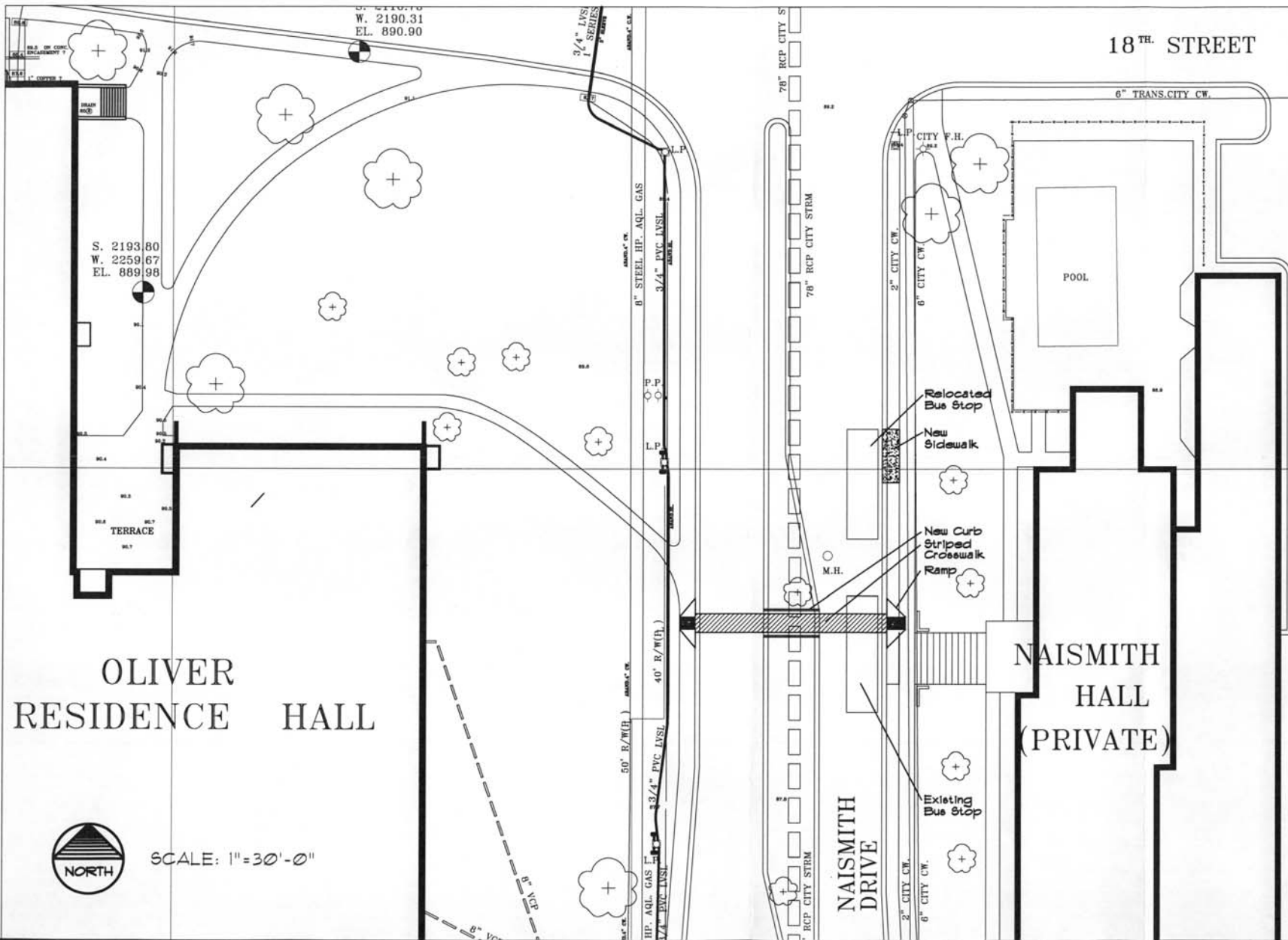
Request to Install Pedestrian Crosswalk and Move Transit Stop, the University of Kansas, Lawrence, Kansas

February 12, 2008

The Campus Safety Advisory Board (CSAB) of the University of Kansas has requested that a crosswalk be installed across Naismith Avenue just north of 19th Street to improve safety along the "path" that students have worn across the Naismith median in traveling between Naismith Hall and Oliver Hall.

For crosswalk safety, the University is also requesting approval for the relocation of the transit stop that is currently on the east side of Naismith Drive directly in front of the west front door to Naismith Hall. With the current transit stop location, pedestrians would be moving into the crosswalk from behind a stopped bus.

The new transit stop location would remain along the east side of Naismith Drive and be moved to the north, with the relocated north end of the transit stop zone located approximately 120 feet south of the intersection of Naismith Drive and 18th Street. This relocated transit stop will allow pedestrians to use the crosswalk with an unobstructed view to oncoming traffic from the south. Please refer to the attached exhibit.
