Lawrence Electronic Recycling Event

On Saturday, April 26, 2008, the City's Waste Reduction & Recycling Division hosted the first Electronic Recycling Event in Lawrence. The event was held from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the University of Kansas Lied Center parking lot located at 1600 Stewart Drive.

This event was co-sponsored by Hamm Waste Services.

Electronic recycling was provided by Asset LifeCycle, a permitted e-waste recycling and reclamation facility in the State of Kansas.

Event/Survey Summary:

- 676 vehicles participated representing 633 residences and 89 businesses.
- 91% of the 676 vehicles were Lawrence residences and businesses. Other participants were from Baldwin, DeSoto, Eudora, Kansas City, Lecompton, Linwood, Leavenworth, Overbrook, Perry, Overland Park, Tonganoxie, Topeka, Wellsville, Winchester, McLouth.
- 72% of vehicles brought 5 or less electronic items. 22% of vehicles brought 6 to 15 items. 5% brought more than 15 items. 1% did not respond this survey question.
- A total of 60,051 pounds of computer monitors, printers, copiers, televisions and other electronics were collected for recycling.
- 582 computer monitors and 223 televisions were collected for recycling in addition to other electronics.
