### **Rock Chalk Run Route Proposal**

Start of Race: Race starts at 0800.

- Athletes will start just north of 9th and New Hampshire, allowing enough space to keep 9th Street open east/westbound. Prior to the start of the race, athlete staging area will take place at the parking lot located at the NE corner of 9th & New Hampshire Streets. The property owner (Aquila) and current businesses (Adecco, Aquila, Lan Gegenheimer, D.M.D. and Lawrence Bank) have been contacted and we have received permission to use their parking lot.
- Athletes will travel northbound on New Hampshire. The intersections of New Hampshire and 7th/8th Streets will be closed from approximately 0750-0810. The intersections will be closed by barricades. The Lawrence Downtown Farmer Market coordinator and directors have been notified of this temporary street closure and we have their support.
- Athletes will be making their way across the bridge to the levee trail. The east lane
  of the bridge will be coned off from traffic the length of the bridge. The west lane
  will be left open to through traffic. Barricades would be needed to block
  automobile traffic of the east lane on the bridge. The barricades would leave
  enough room for runners to pass through onto the bridge.
- Once the last runner has crossed the bridge the barricades/cones would be removed and traffic would return to normal on the bridge. Estimated time 0815-0820.
- After crossing the bridge athletes will be directed eastbound on the levee trail and will turn around and follow the same route back to the bridge.
- Athletes will then return southbound on the bridge walkway. (Athletes will be spread out by this time)
- After crossing the bridge athletes will turn east on Massachusetts/curving into New Hampshire. Athletes will stay on the sidewalk (\*) and head southbound on New Hampshire. Athletes will then turn east and travel through The World Company parking lot. (\*\*) Athletes will exit The World Company parking lot onto Rhode Island Street and turn south.

- Athletes will travel southbound on Rhode Island crossing 7th and 8th streets.
- Athletes will finish at 9th and New Hampshire in the southeast vacant lot owned by 9-10, L.C. In order to have a clear and adequate path for the runners to reach the finish line, some concrete barriers will have to be temporary moved before the race. These concrete barriers are located along the northern edge of the 9-10, L.C. property line and 9th Street. Race organizers will be responsible for removing and putting back the barriers.
- (\*) Allowing athletes to stay on the sidewalk for this short duration will keep New Hampshire open without disruption. There is also not an adequate curb to "drop" athletes down to the street. This eliminates an officer here. This is subject to change if there is an excess of 600 athletes.

(\*\*)This is also a suggestion to keep athletes off of New Hampshire. This eliminates another officer. (If this does not work then athletes will be directed to 7th street where they will turn east.)



Officers will move from the above posts to the ones below upon athletes returning.


