This letter is to provide you with another update related to our request for vacation of the ROW of the East side of Indiana St.

Since my last letter, the shoring has been placed along the East property line and excavation of the hard shale below the shoring is nearly to the final sub-grade elevation.


The geotechnical engineer would like to observe the hard shale excavation below the shoring and analyze how it reacts to being exposed before making his final determination on the offset distance.

This observation timeframe is not a set number of days, but it will not take more than two weeks. So rather than continue one week just to possibly continue another week, we would like to request a continuation of our request for vacation to the July 15th City Commission meeting.

Again, once we have a definitive answer on the location of the hotel and the subsequent width of vacation of right-of-way we will let you know immediately.
