Dear Joseph,

Thank you for taking the time to meet with me on Friday about our film project, Earthwork. We are very excited to be working in Lawrence and showcasing our wonderful downtown area!

As mentioned, we would like to request permission to close both sides of Massachusetts Street on August 4 between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Street. In addition, we would like 4 parking meters on each side of the street, bagged going north from 8<sup>th</sup> Street. It has been suggested that these meters be bagged and barricades in place starting at 5P on Sunday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> so as to keep cars from being in these spaces when we officially arrive at 6A on August 4<sup>th</sup>.

We would also like to have barricades and police officers at both 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> to prohibit North/South vehicular traffic from entering onto Massachusetts Street. Traffic on 9<sup>th</sup> Street going east and west can continue to flow. We will need to have intermittent traffic control going north and south on Massachusetts near the intersection at 8<sup>th</sup> street, during filming currently scheduled in the morning, as our scene takes place in the 70's and we will not want to see any newer vehicles.

We will post production assistants on the sidewalks to ensure the safety of customers as well as to intermittently control foot traffic on the street during actual filming.

We will be working with Martin Moore to secure parking for our basecamp operations on the grass at the corner of 9<sup>th</sup> and New Hampshire.

I am attaching a script and a letter of support from Downtown Lawrence, Inc. Please let me know if I can answer questions or supply additional information.
