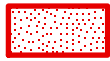


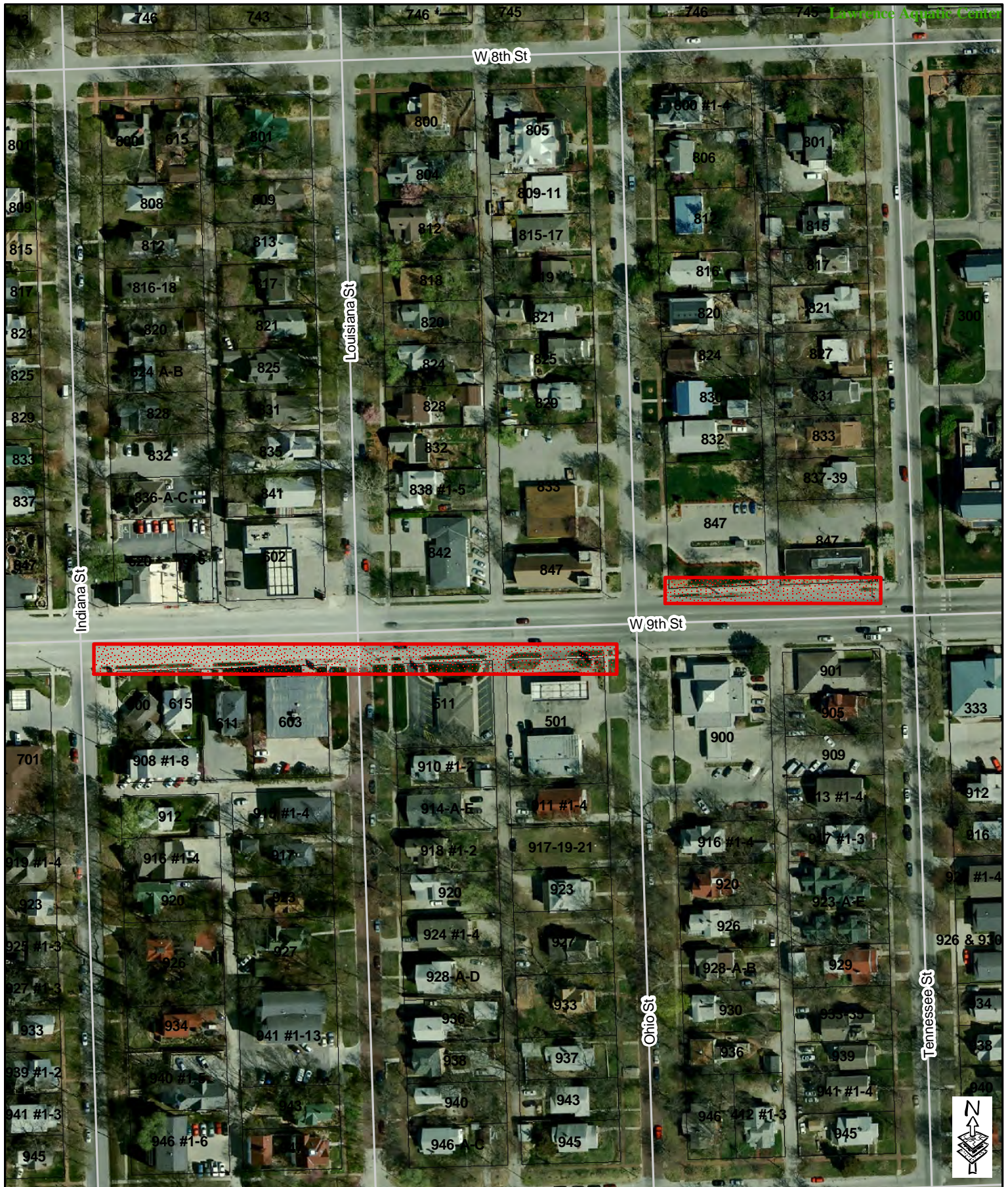

**RE: REMOVAL OF ON-STREET PARKING ALONG WEST 9TH STREET
(BETWEEN TENNESSEE AND INDIANA).**

To Whom It May Concern:

On July 6, 2009 the Traffic Safety Commission (TSC) of the City of Lawrence will consider removal of on-street parking along West 9th Street between Tennessee and Indiana (see attached map). The meeting will begin at 7:00 pm in the City Commission Room, City Hall, 6th E. 6th Street. Removal of on-street parking as shown on the attached map will make room for bike lanes along this stretch of West 9th Street. Members of the Lawrence Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC) will also attend the TSC meeting and present their recommendations regarding bike lanes.

The TSC will receive public comments on this issue at the July 6th meeting.

Pending public comments, the TSC will make recommendations to the Lawrence City Commission. Recommendations from the TSC to the City Commission will be considered by the City Commission at the July 07, 2009 City Commission meeting. Members of the public may speak to this issue at the City Commission meeting as well.
