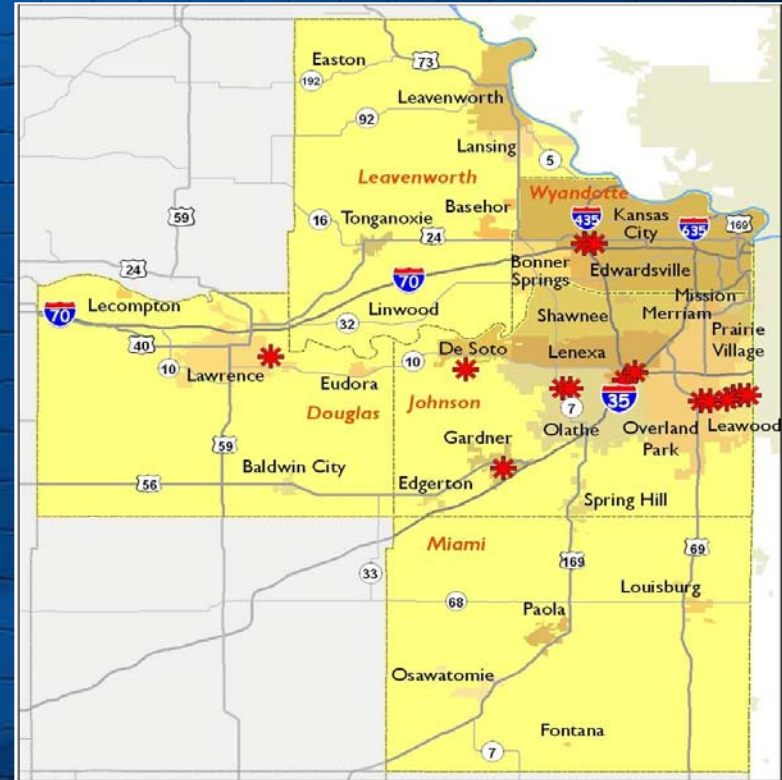

Study Scope

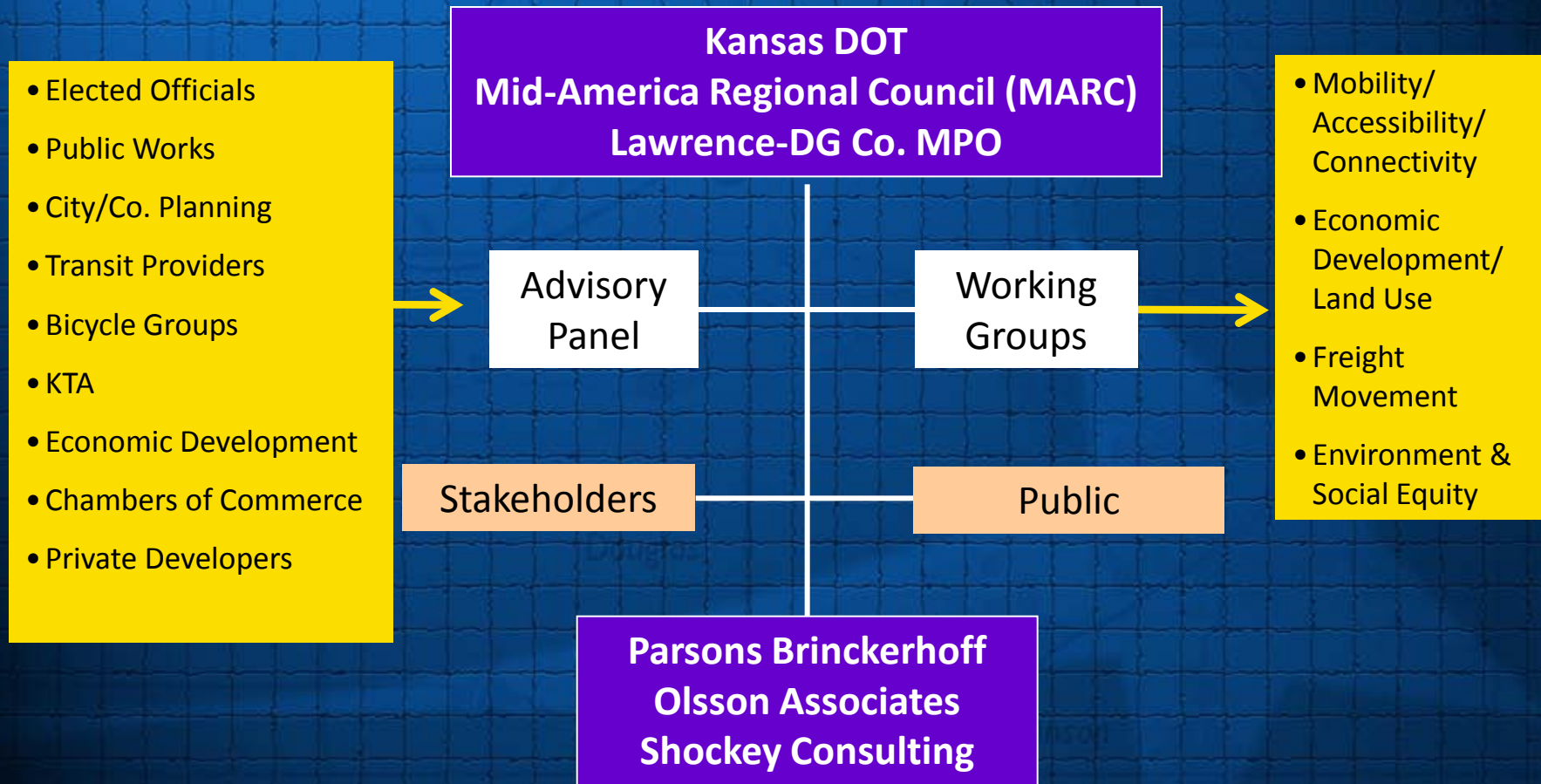
- Transportation – Multimodal

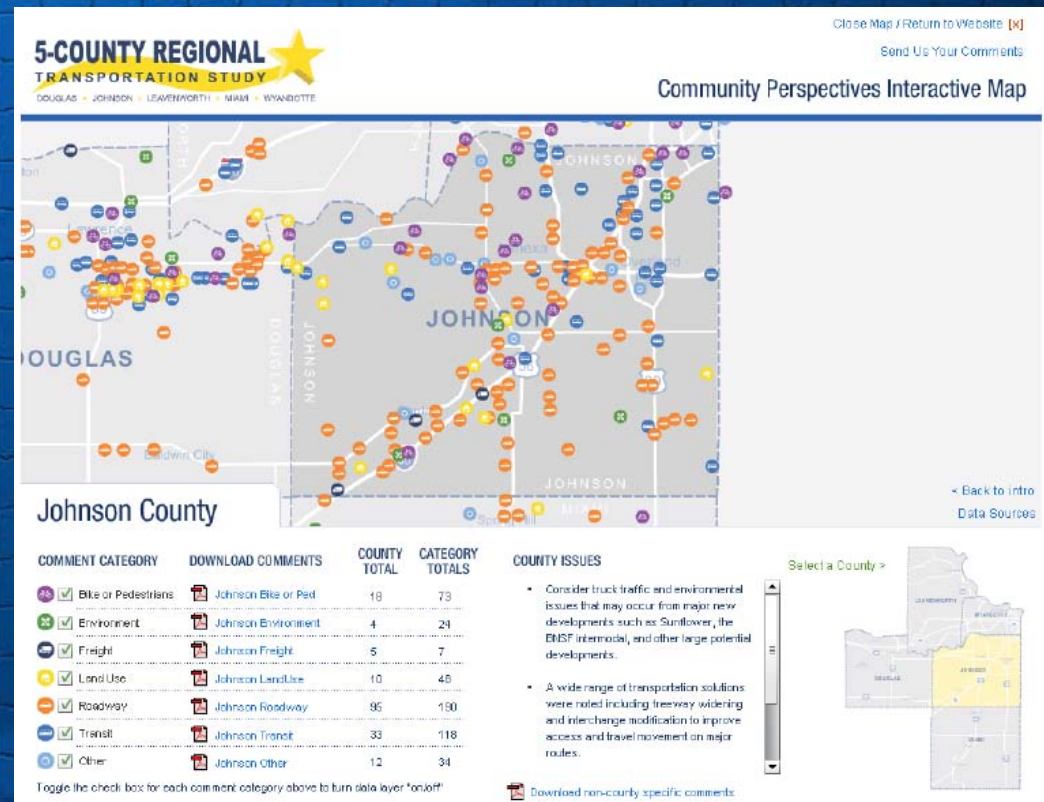

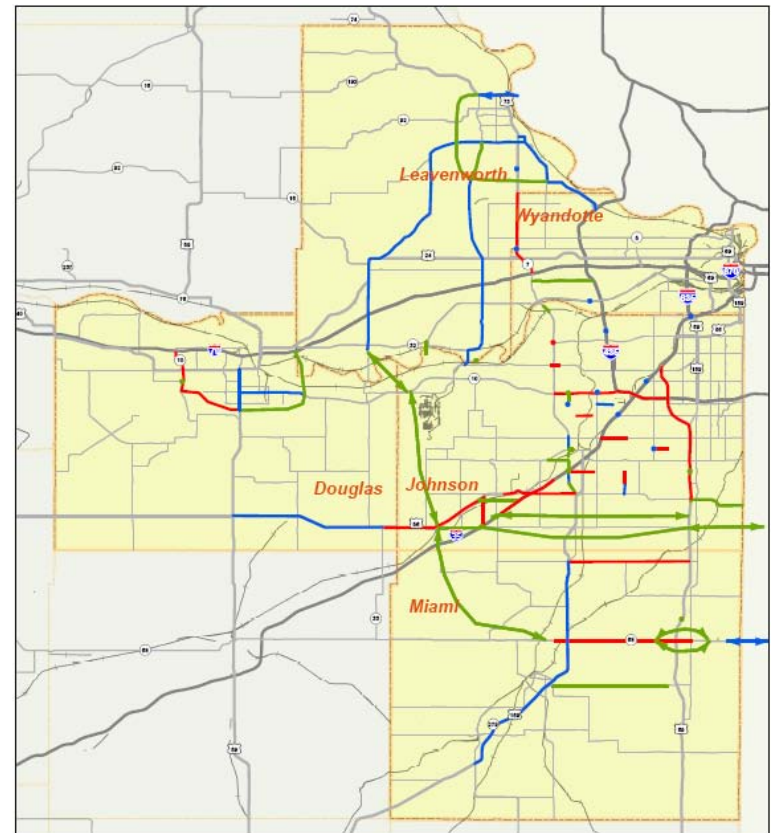

Legend

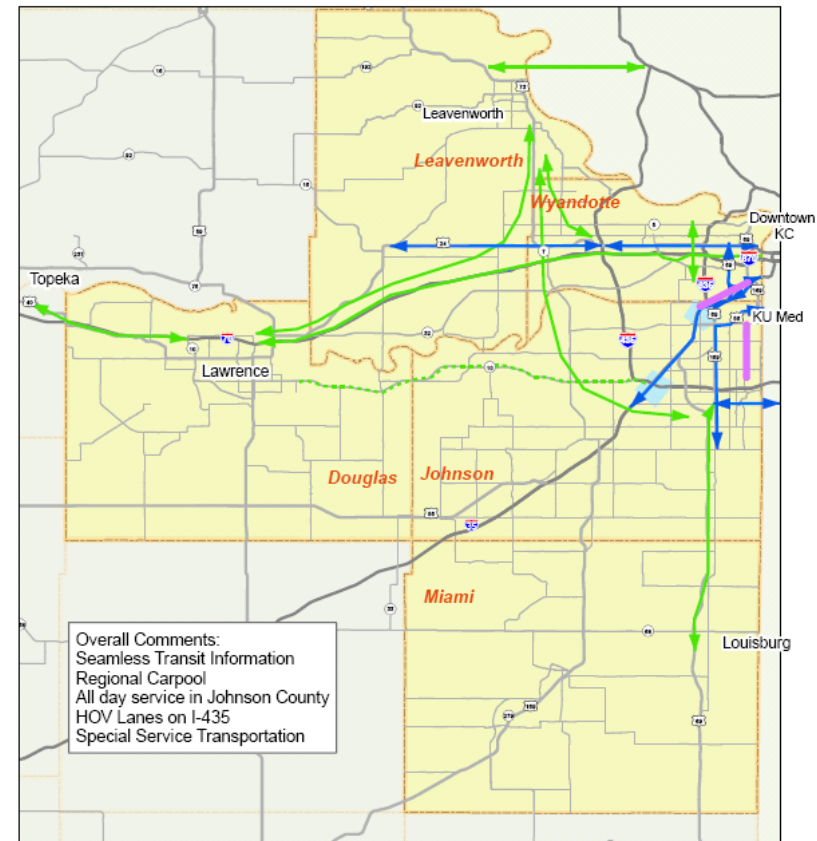
- Improve Existing Roadways
