The wall mural I'm proposing to paint on 12th and Haskell will be a recycling themed mural. All images will be very bright and colorful, with many healing images of people cleaning up the earth and recycling the products they use. There will be different panels all connected by the same back ground image. The first panel will start off with an image of a large native bur oak and a play ground/park. There will be children and adults picking up garbage to be recycled. The next panel will be a large image of the earth surrounded by recycling arrows, reduce, re-use, recycle. There will be three children in the bottom right hand corner recycling along with our "think green" recycling raccoon. The think green recycling raccoon will appear in different settings through out the mural. The next panel will be filled with images of beautiful rolling Kansas hills, native plants and wildlife. Along the sides of this native land will be images of cans, bottles, plastic, paper, lots of heavy metals, all piles of recyclable materials. Out of the piles of recyclable materials green sprouts will be growing up to the sun and then dieing back into the earth to symbolize the natural composting of the earth, which is the earths natural way of recycling. This will also symbolize how we help the earth to stay green and healthy when we are responsible with our actions and recycle what we use. In the sky, will appear examples of the different recyclable materials. Then there will appear a garbage can displaying how, when we recycle and compost, there really is nothing left to throw away!!! In the back ground will be a healing rainbow with the sun coming up over the horizon, symbolizing the birth of a new dawn. A dawn of people taking responsibility for there actions and caring for the earth that gives them life!!! 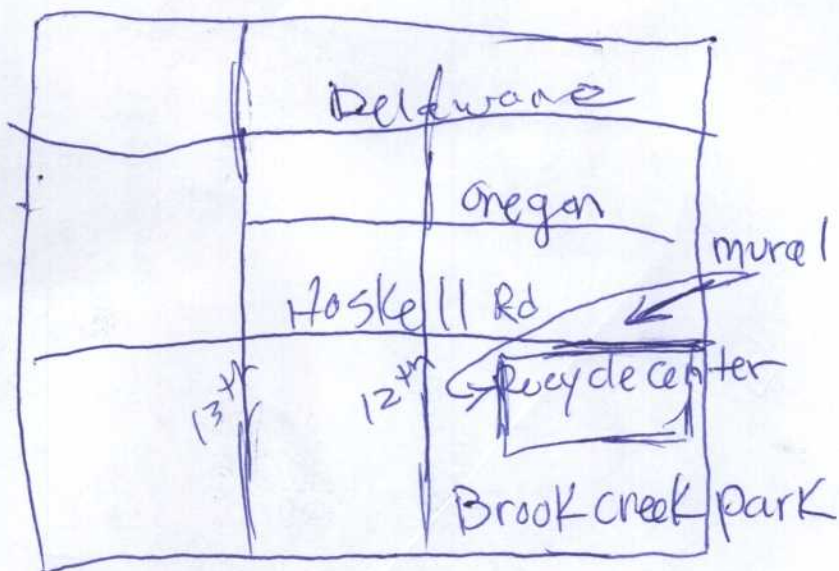

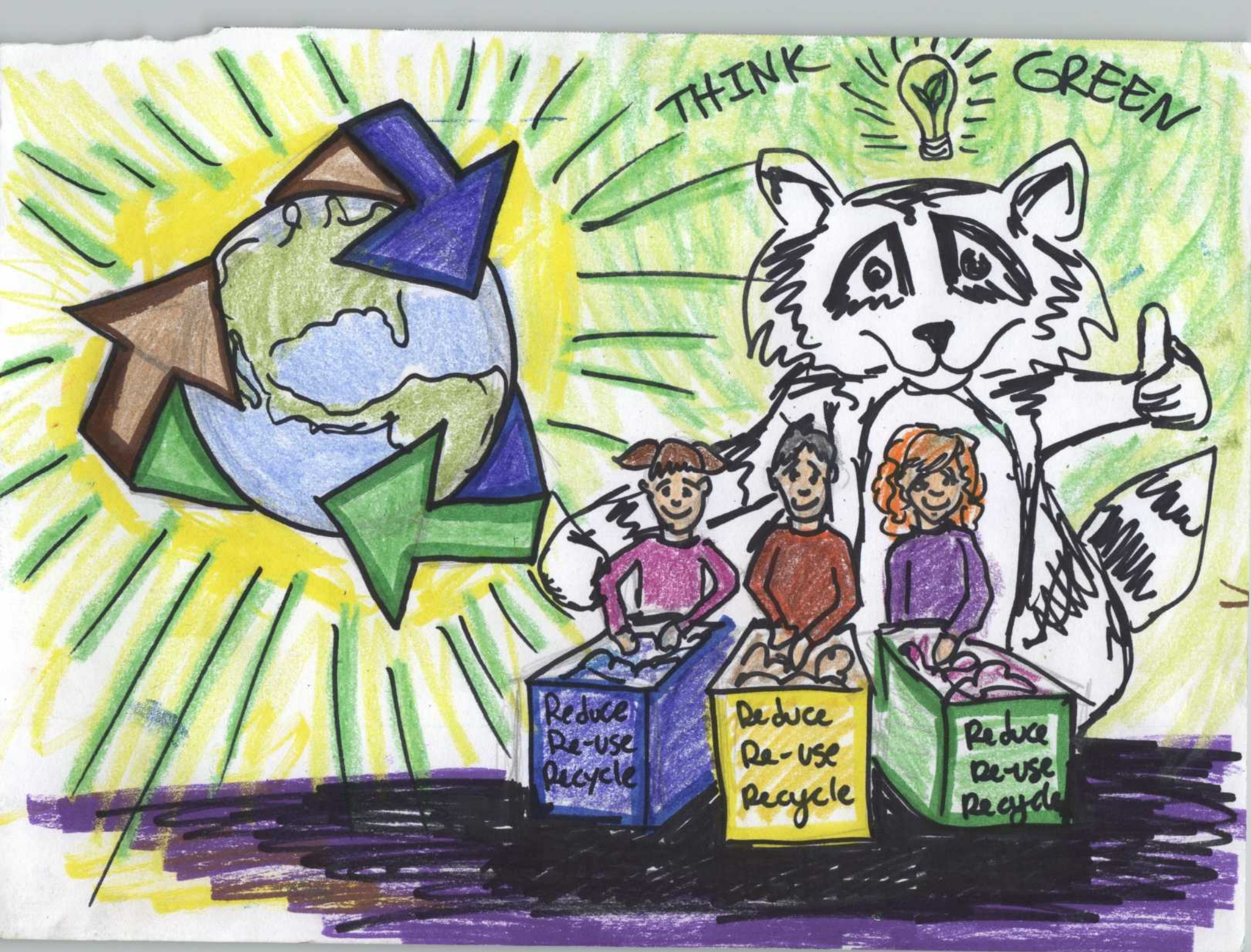

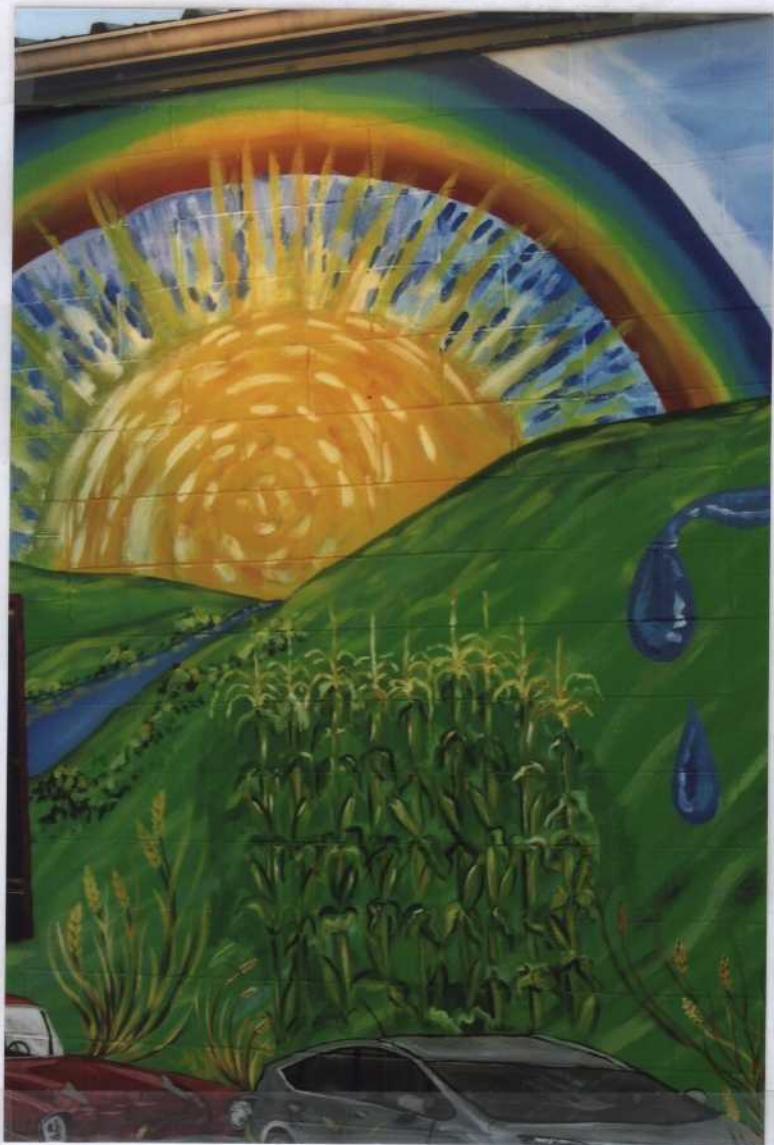
