The Lawrence Home Builders Association requests exemption from Section 5-705.1 of the Sign Ordinance for our annual Home Show, January 29<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup>.

We would like to place signs at a few key intersections and in front of the businesses of Home Show exhibitors who have given us permission. The signs are planned to be 18" X 24" in size with wire posts to secure them in the ground. Below are proposed locations for the signage:

- Clinton Parkway & Wakarusa
- Clinton Parkway & Inverness
- Clinton Parkway & Kasold
- Clinton Parkway & Lawrence Avenue
- Wakarusa & Bob Billings Parkway
- Wakarusa & 6<sup>th</sup> Street
- Kasold & Bob Billings Parkway
- 23<sup>rd</sup> & Harper

The signs would be placed Monday, January 25<sup>th</sup>, and removed Monday, February 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Home Show has approximately 70 displays featuring home related products and services. The purpose of the Home Show is to allow those in the construction industry to highlight the latest in home building products, services, and trends. We typically have over 2,000 visitors to this community event. It is held at the First Serve Tennis Club, 5200 Clinton Parkway.
