AN ACT concerning cities and counties; relating to residential fire protection sprinkler systems.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. As used in this act:

(a) "Municipality" means any city or county.
(b) "Residential structure" means any improvement to real property to be used or occupied as a single-family dwelling or multi-family dwelling

of four attached living units or less.

Sec. 2. On and after July 1, 2010, no municipality shall adopt or enforce any ordinance, order, code, standard or rule requiring the installation of a multi-purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any other fire sprinkler protection system in any residential structure. Nothing in this section shall prohibit any person from voluntarily installing a multi-purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any other fire

22 in this section shall prohibit any person from voluntarily installing a multi-23 purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any other fire 24 sprinkler protection system in a residential structure.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
