- RE: Text Amendment Initiation for Hotel/Motel/Extended Stay use in the IL District

The <u>request</u> was made by Paul Werner Architects to initiate text amendments to the Land Development Code regarding the "Hotel/Motel/Extended Stay" use in the IL (Light-Industrial) District. Currently no "Transient Accommodation" uses are permitted in any industrial district.

The setbacks for the industrial districts range from 25' to 50' abutting public right-of-way depending on the adjacent street classification and the zoning designation across the street. The applicant has also suggested that less intensive uses wouldn't need such as large setback. Further review of these setbacks would need to be completed to determine if they are appropriate for the permitted uses in the district.

Action requested: Consider initiating text amendments to various sections of the Land Development Code, Chapter 20 – Code of the City of Lawrence, Kansas regarding the "Hotel/Motel/Extended Stay" use and the "Density and Dimensional Standards" of the industrial districts.
