RE: Text Amendment Initiation to review the maximum density in the

RM32 District

The request was made by Paul Werner Architects to initiate a text amendment to the *Land Development Code* regarding the maximum density for the RM32 (Multi-Dwelling Residential) District. Currently the maximum density in the district is 32 dwelling units per acre.

The applicant is requesting that the RM32 District's maximum density be reviewed to remove the cap for the district if all other requirements of the code are met, parking, landscaping, minimum outdoor area per dwelling, etc. Currently the RM32 District is the most dense residential district. Further review of the RM density maximums would need to be completed to determine if a change is appropriate.

Action requested: Consider initiating a text amendment to Chapter 20, Section 601 of the Land Development Code – Code of the City of Lawrence, Kansas.
