Dear Mayor Amyx,

The Lawrence Home Builders Association requests exemption from Section 5-705.1 of the Sign Ordinance during our annual Fall Parade of Homes.

The Fall Parade of Homes takes place over two weekends, September 25th & 26th and October 2nd & 3rd. Typically, the builder sets out directional arrows the Saturday morning of the first weekend and then the LHBA removes the signs the Monday following the second weekend. According to the Sign Ordinance, we are noncompliant by leaving the directional arrows in place Monday through Friday between the first and second weekend.

There are 14 homes on the Fall Parade of Homes, all in Lawrence. The purpose of our tour is to highlight the latest in home building features and trends and to give the community a composite of the types of newly built homes available in Lawrence and surrounding areas.
