- WHEREAS: Many Lawrence citizens and City employees have followed in the footsteps of those first recruits and other Marines by serving their country throughout the world; and
- **WHEREAS**: For many years, these former Marines have hosted a Birthday Celebration for the United States Marine Corps, inviting all the citizens of Lawrence and all Marines; and
- WHEREAS: On November 10, 2010, the United States Marine Corps will be celebrating its 235th anniversary; and
- **WHEREAS:** On this day, Marines all around the world will be celebrating 235 years of honor, courage, and dedication to duty; and
- **WHEREAS**: This year's Birthday Celebration will be held at the Dole Institute of Politics in Lawrence, Kansas, at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, November 10, 2010;
