RE: Adoption of the 2011 Action Plan and Investment Summary

The City Commission will consider adoption of the 2011 Action Plan and Investment Summary at their regular meeting Tuesday, May 3, 2011. The Consolidated Plan is required by the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 and is the result of a collaborative process whereby a community establishes a unified vision for community development using federal, state, and local funds.

The 2011 Action Plan includes the one year Investment Summary (<u>attached</u> and page 3 in the Action Plan) for the upcoming 2011 program year (August 1, 2011 through July 31, 2012). The Action Plan is available on the department website at <u>www.lawrenceks.org/pds</u> and has been recently updated as staff was just made aware of the final CDBG and HOME allocations.

When Congress adopted the 2011 budget in late April, staff worked with the CDAC to refine the Investment Summary to reflect the estimated reduced allocations which included a proposed 17% cut in CDBG funds and 1% cut in HOME funding. The final numbers reflect an actual cut of 16.2% in CDBG, allowing an additional \$5,292 to be added back to public services, administration, and capital improvement projects. Since public services are limited to 15% of the grant, this amounted to an additional \$88 per grant for the five neighborhood associations and four public service agencies. Administration was increased by \$1,095 to \$146,065 and capital improvements (Weatherization) increased \$3,441 to \$71,987.

The HOME program final allocation was reduced nearly 12% so additional funds have been cut from that budget as well. Administration and the CHDO Operating Expenses were reduced to remain within the regulatory of cap of 10% and 5% respectively. Allocations to the Lawrence-Douglas County Housing Authority, Lawrence Habitat for Humanity and Tenants to Homeowners (CHDO Set-Aside) were maintained and the First Time Homebuyer Program was reduced to \$97,331 from an originally proposed \$162,366 as that program continues to experience a lull, likely attributable to the economy.

Staff will be available to answer questions and the Chair of the Community Development Advisory Committee, Julie Mitchell, will also be present at the meeting.

To date, no written comments have been received by the department.
