The Lawrence Citizens' Advisory Board was created to help develop our department's current policy on Racial Profiling. Throughout the year the Lawrence Citizens' Advisory Board examines all complaints of racial profiling along with our departments response to each instance. Each year a report is compiled to send to the office of the Attorney General for the State of Kansas.

Beginning in 2011, the Lawrence Police Department will be required to report all instances of Racial Profiling by July 31 as per the requirements of the new KSA 22-4610 (d)(1). This is change from the previous reporting date of January 31. In the future the timeframe for the completing the annual report will mirror the fiscal year.

Between January 1, 2011 and June 30, 2011 there were no reports of Racial Profiling. This six month period will put us in sync with the States' new reporting requirement. Attached is our Racial Profiling Report for 2011 to date.

(2) The annual report shall include: (A) The number of racial or other biased-based policing complaints received; (B) the date each racial or other biased-based policing complaint; (D) the disposition of each racial or other biased-based policing complaint; (E) the date each racial or other biased-based policing complaint is closed; (F) whether or not all agency law enforcement officers not exempted by Kansas commission on peace officers' standards and training received the training required in subsection (c)(2)(A); (G) whether the agency has a policy prohibiting racial or other biased-based policing; (H) whether the agency policy mandates specific discipline for sustained complaints of racial or other biased-based policing; (I) whether the agency has a community advisory board; and (J) whether the agency has a racial or other biased-based policing comprehensive plan or if it collects traffic or pedestrian stop data.
