Possible Locations:

This would be based on the City of Lawrence approval as to where the boxes are placed.

We would recommend using drop sites near restaurants, bars and other City of Lawrence recycle boxes.

We would use a 20 yard 16' long closed top roll off box that would hold approximately 8000 lbs or 4 ton of glass.

We would have an employee check on the boxes and when they are filled we would take an empty box and switch out the full box and go drop the glass at the collection site. If there was any broken glass on the ground the driver would clean it up.

We would use an over the road hauler to haul glass from the collection site to Waste Connections, Inc. located in Hutchinson Kansas. They use recycled glass to make insulation. Their web site is www.wasteconnections.com.

We would take all of the glass to the collection site on approval of the City of Lawrence.

We would collect the glass when the box is full and take it to the collection site. We would load the glass into an open top semi trailer with our loader and operator once a week or when we have approximately 26 tons of glass to be shipped to Waste Connections, Inc.

We would weigh the glass on the large scale at 12th & Haskell Recycle Center so that we know how much is being recycled and Kathy Richardson of the City of Lawrence would also receive a copy of the scale ticket. We would also send monthly statements of weights to Kathy Richardson of the City of Lawrence.

Cost of Services:

12th & Haskell Recycle Center provides all aspects of the glass recycling.

I have contacted a land owner just west of 31st and Haskell who would let me lease space on his land for glass collection and for loading the glass onto semi trailers upon the City of Lawrence approval.

Start up Cost:

Lump Sum Payment \$65,000.00

Maintenance Cost: \$10,000.00/month

Pick Up and Delivery to Collection Site \$30.00/ton

We take the full semi trailer to our Ottawa location and sort the recycling and ship it to our different vendors. We pick up full trailers weekly and we ship product weekly. BMS Logistics provides Wal-Mart with their monthly recycle weights that they receive from 12th & Haskell Recycle Center.
