The Governor has now declared the vast majority of the state to be in some stage of drought-emergency, warning or watch. Clinton Lake and its watershed are located in counties that are either in a Watch or Warning status. Giving consideration to the county declarations, the percent of conservation pool remaining and the downward trend in streamflow, the Kansas Water Office is issuing a drought watch for water marketing customers from Clinton Lake. This issuance should trigger your Conservation Plan Water Watch stage.
