Standard Conditions for Alcohol on Public Right-of-Way

The following condition shall apply to Temporary Use of Public Right-of-Way Permits issued by the city for events at which alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage will be possessed and consumed on the public right-of-way.

The permit holder will not allow anyone under the age of 21 to possess, purchase or consume alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage.

The boundaries of the event or portion of the event held on the public right-of-way shall be clearly marked by a three-dimensional obstacle such as crowd control barriers, orange snow fencing or similar temporary fencing product. The permit holder will not allow open containers of alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage to be carried beyond the clearly marked boundaries of the event.

The permit holder will not deny immediate entry and inspection by law enforcement officers or code enforcement officers.

The permit holder will not allow the consumption of alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage outside the hours stated in the ordinance allowing possession and consumption on the right-of-way, and in no cases between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.

The permit holder will comply with applicable city and county laws and with all the provisions of the Kansas Liquor Control Act, Club and Drinking Establishment Act and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.

The permit holder will meet any other conditions of any City of Lawrence or State of Kansas Permit or License issued for the event.
