



LPRD HOSTS KANSAS AVIATION CAMP

The Kansas Aviation Youth Camp was held Saturday, June 2, at the University of Kansas Aerospace Engineering hangar on the west side of the Lawrence Municipal Airport. The camp was designed to offer introduction to area middle school students on the fundamentals of flight

The camp, sponsored by Kansas Commission Aerospace Education and the City of Lawrence Parks & Recreation Department offered 25 kids ages 12-15 class modules that included Flight Planning and How to Fly an Aircraft, Aviation Weather, Weight/Balance, Careers in Aviation and the Airport: Traffic Patterns and Communications. The camp also included a 20 minute flight over Lawrence.

The Kansas Aviation Youth Camp was a joint partnership of the Lawrence Municipal Airport Aviation Advisory Board, the Lawrence Parks and Recreation Department, the University of Kansas Aerospace Engineering Department, and the Kansas Commission on Aerospace Education (KCAE).
