

Resolution of Intent

Announce intent to consider adoption of an organized recycling collection service.

Invite participation of interested persons.

Include specific goals to be achieved, detail justification for franchise fees, if any, and other reasons for considering service.

Publish Resolution in newspaper.

Give notice of the hearing on plan.

The Plan


Describe procedures for development of plan and compliance with notice provisions.

Evaluate plan: achieving stated goals, minimizing displacement / economic impact on current collectors, ensuring participation of interested parties in decision making process, and maximizing efficiency in collection.

Provide detailed justification for tax, fees.

Give notice of the hearing on plan to recycling haulers.

30 days prior to hearing.



At least 180 days.



18 months from adoption of Ordinance.



90 days after adopting Resolution.

Develop plan for service.
Invite recycling haulers to all planning meetings.

City Commission will receive draft plan and RFP after planning is complete.

Approve RFP.

If for any reason an organized collection service is not implemented by passage of an Ordinance within one year of the passage of a Resolution of Intent, the process shall be started over.
