- 1. Kasold Drive is classified as an "arterial" street with two northbound through lanes at 6th Street.
- 2. Peak-hour traffic counts obtained show that during both the AM and PM peak-hours, over 55% of the northbound traffic makes a right-turn, while less than 45% of the traffic continues northbound.
- 3. If the right lane is designated as a right-turn only lane, pavement markings and signing would have to be installed.

Commissioner Ziegelmeyer: Hopefully it would cut-down on the number of motorists that cut-thru the drugstore parking lot.

Commissioner Russell: I think it's a valid proposal that has been put forth and just because the proponent isn't here I don't think we should negate the fact that the traffic counts have shown that 55% is turning right.

Commissioner Ziegelmeyer: I agree with Commissioner Russell; I think it is a valid request and I think it makes sense.
