

FAQ'S --URGENT REPAIRS AT THE LAWRENCE INDOOR AQUATIC CENTER

THE LPRD INDOOR AQUATIC CENTER LEISURE POOL WILL CLOSE THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 20 FOR REPAIR WORK BEING PERFORMED ON CORRODING SUPPORT BRACKETS.

WHAT'S GOING ON? WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

A support bracket that secures the ceiling-mounted heat ducts failed due to extensive corrosion. Maintenance crews became aware of the problem and are working to make repairs immediately. An area around the defective equipment has been temporarily closed as a precaution.

WHAT ARE THEY WORKING ON?

The maintenance crews will be working to secure the heat ducts to the ceiling with additional supports. Because the indoor pool is a harsh environment for anything metal, bolts and fasteners may corrode calling for repair or replacement.

WHEN WILL IT START? WHEN WILL IT END?

Crews will close the leisure pool and work **Thursday, September 20, through Friday, September 21**. The leisure pool will open as scheduled on Saturday, September 22. Repairs will only affect the LEISURE POOL. The competition pool will remain open for public swimming, instructional classes and swim team practices.

WHY WASN'T THIS WORK DONE DURING THE REGULAR AUGUST SHUTDOWN?

We just became aware of this problem. The heating ducts are critical to the operations of the pool--so making these repairs now is very important.

WHY DO YOU HAVE TO DRAIN THE POOL IF THEY ARE WORKING ON THE CEILING?

To reach the ceiling, crews will use a scissor lift allowing access to the inside ceiling of the pool. Draining the water is necessary to use this equipment and ensure worker safety.

WILL I RECEIVE AN EXTENSION ON MY ANNUAL OR MONTHLY PASS?

WHEN WILL SWIMMING LESSONS AND FITNESS CLASSES HAVE MAKEUPS?
