Public Works Department continues to incorporate and promote Energy savings

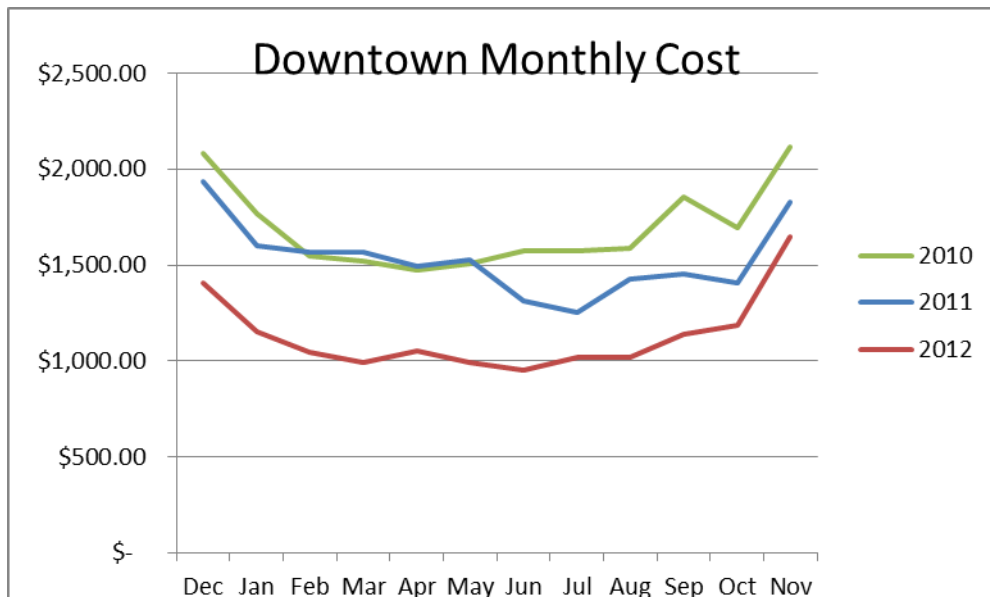
The Department of Public Works has been making energy savings improvements to Downtown lighting. The area covered is Massachusetts St. from 7th to North Park and west side of New Hampshire from 9th to 10th.

- June 2011 – Pedestrian lights south of 9th changed to LED @ 100 watt
- December 2011 – Pedestrian lights north of 9th changed to LED @ 50 watt
- December 2012 – Pedestrian lights north of 9th were changed to 50 watt from 100 watt

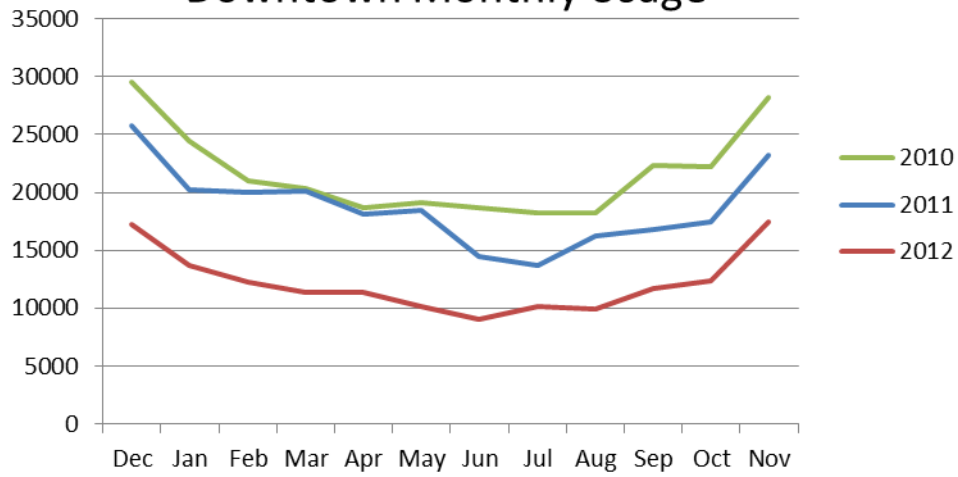
Savings 2012 vs 2010
