The Department of Public Works has been making energy savings improvements to Downtown lighting. The area covered is Massachusetts St. from 7<sup>th</sup> to North Park and west side of New Hampshire from 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>.

- June 2011 Pedestrian lights south of 9<sup>th</sup> changed to LED @ 100 watt
  December 2011 Pedestrian lights north of 9<sup>th</sup> changed to LED @ 50 watt
- December 2012 Pedestrian lights north of 9<sup>th</sup> were changed to 50 watt from 100 watt
