Support for recommendation for curbside recycling program

The Sustainability Advisory Board met in a special session on Monday, February 11, 2013, to discuss the pending recommendations of the RFP Review Committee.

The Sustainability Advisory Board supports the recommendation to authorize staff to negotiate with Hamm for MRF operations under the proposal for the City to provide biweekly curbside recycling service.

The SAB strongly supports the implementation of a city-wide curbside recycling program. The board further supports the goal set out by the Solid Waste Task Force of reaching a 50 percent recycling rate by 2020.

This is an exciting opportunity for the community in terms of both curbside recycling and local economic impact. Several of the benefits include:
