Dear Resident,

The City appreciates your attendance at the neighborhood meeting held on January 30th to present and discuss the site plan and architectural renderings for Pump Station #10. Based on the written and verbal public comments received, the Utilities Department will be recommending the full berm green roof option #3 to the City Commission at the meeting on April 22, 2014. As discussed at the public meeting, a fully bermed green roof will provide the following benefits:

- Energy Efficiency – The greater insulation offered by the bermed green roof will reduce the amount of energy needed to moderate the temperature of the structure.
- Roof Durability – The life expectancy of the bermed green roof exceeds that of traditional roof materials.
- Stormwater Management – Green roofs reduce stormwater runoff by decreasing impervious area on the site.

We welcome your attendance at the Tuesday, April 22nd City Commission meeting at 6:35 p.m. in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, 6 East 6th Street. The fully bermed green roof recommendation for Pump Station #10 will be a regular agenda item and public comments are encouraged.
