Dear Cultural Arts Commissioners,

The New York Elementary 4th and 5th graders are working on research for a mural about the history of their school and neighborhood with KT Walsh and Mitch Pearson, Art Teacher. Nancy Del Garmo, our intrepid Principal applied for and won a small starter grant from the Lawrence Schools Foundation and Dave Lowenstein, Van Go Mobile Arts and Walsh have donated paint and supplies.

Arch and John Naramore have generously agreed to let us paint on the north wall of their building at 601 E. 9th. Because of the recent development at 9th and N.H. that will result in the removal (and replacement?) of The Pollinators mural, Ms. De Garmo has asked us to use materials that can be attached to the wall and removed later if need be.

These added expenses and other costs will be covered by an Indiegogo crowd funding campaign we will launch soon.

I've taken the four classes on tours of the neighborhood and at the Martin Luther King Chili Feed the kids set up listening stations in the library to gather adults' memories of their time at New York School.

We have long time neighborhood residents coming in and sharing post-Quantrill to 2014 East Lawrence history with the students. The mural design process begins next week. We hope to have them outside painting by October and be done by Halloween before it gets too cold.

The work is incorporated into their Core Curriculum of Social Studies, Art and English.

We are requesting approval of our mural permit with the assurance that it will be family friendly and will not contain any commercial content.
