

Additional request

The Lawrence Arts Center (LAC) request for city approvals and support for the 2015 Free State Festival:

The event has three components: outdoor digital media displays on various private and public buildings throughout the Lawrence Cultural District June 22 – 28; outdoor film showings at the Lawrence Arts Center (South Wall/green space) June 5, 12, 19 and 26; and outdoor music on Wednesday, June 24 and Saturday June 27. LAC staff mailed notification of the City Commission consideration of this item to properties located near the outdoor event and display sites. The various components of this request for approval/support follow.

Additional Requests (Updated May 18, 2015)

1. ART INSTALLATION (NO PARKING SIGNAGE) –parking stall directly in front of the Bourgeois Pkg. 6 E. ninth.
2. CHALK DRAWING CLASS - A class from the University of Kansas under the direction of artists Stephen Johnson would like permission to do chalk drawings as a part of the festival in public places throughout the cultural district. A list is a below. All chalk drawings will be cleaned off by Monday, June 29th at the latest.
 - a. US bank pavilion is close to the building, nearest the flag pole planter structure - 2 concrete sections 6 ft square each (not blocking any doors)
 - b. Breezeway in the 800 Block of Massachusetts Street – on the North Wall, not on the sidewalk
 - c. 900 Rhode Island
 - d. 720 E. 9th Street
 - e. LAC Patio area
3. ART INSTALLATION - We also need to request one section of the sidewalk on Vermont directly west of the ATT tower, but on the east sidewalk. Scaffolding would be installed so that the sidewalk would be accessible. Installation would be June 22-26. Down 27th, end of night.
4. GEORGE CLINTON NO PARKING SIGNS – WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24TH
 - a. we would like to reserve ALL parking spaces on the East and West side of New Hampshire from the end of the Street Closure (North side of the entrance to the Parking Garage) to 10th Street.
 - b. we would like to reserve the street parking space on the Northeast corner of 10th & New Hampshire for the show.
 - c. we would like to reserve two parking spaces on the Northwest corner of 10th & New Hampshire for the show.

5. VINYL LETTERING ON SIDEWALKS – we would like to request permission to place vinyl signage on sidewalks adjacent to Free State Festival sites the week of the festival. The lettering is non-slip, and will be placed on June 21st and removed on Monday, June 29th. A list of Free State Festival locations is below. We may not place these signs at each of these locations but this is a complete possible list.
