

KIDS MAKE A SPLASH WITH AQUATICS

Lawrence Parks and Recreation Department partnered with the Lawrence Public Library to bring the second installment of the *Bookworms and Waterbugs* program this summer. A record number of children and parents, numbering more than 300, participated in the activity that included stories at the Library and swimming at the Outdoor Aquatic Center.



The Aquatic Division also began their summer camps in late-July. The camp consists of swimming activities, including water safety lessons, games and free swims. The camp also includes arts and crafts, games on land and scavenger hunts in Watson Park. The department's OrganWise Guys, nutrition education program, is also integrated during the week, teaching participants about their body's organs and their functions, as well as how to fuel them to run at their highest level.
