


## INTERSECTION REPAIR PROJECT



On Saturday, April 23, Lawrence community members came together at 10th and New Jersey to paint a mural on the pavement at the intersection. The project received a \$1,500 arts grant from the Lawrence Cultural Arts Commission. The total cost of the project is \$3,450. After witnessing a similar project in Portland, OR, Lawrence artist Alicia Kelly proposed the project; which we believe is the first of its kind in the Midwest. Katy Clagett and Jacob Brewer completed the design/project management team for this very successful event.

- Painting participants included about 150 or so from 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.
- Other participants, probably about 200, came to the celebration portion from 4:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.
- Prepping the intersection took 5 hours (sweeping/ power-washing) (2-3 volunteers working)
- Chalking the design took 2 hours with 2-3 volunteers working
- Painting took 5.5 hours (Half hour ahead of schedule!)
- Used 33 gallons of paint and 33 packets of walnut anti-skid additive
- The project generated more than 8000 “views” on city Facebook pages
