Dear Mayor Amyx,

The Lawrence Home Builders Association requests permission to display numbered directional arrows and banners as Signs of Community Interest during our annual Fall Parade of Homes at various locations directing visitors to homes participating in the Parade of Homes.

The Fall Parade of Homes takes place over two weekends, September 24, & 25 and October 1 & 2. The builder sets out directional arrows the Saturday morning of the first weekend and then the LHBA removes the signs no later than Monday following the second weekend. The directional arrows are placed nearby each entry, usually at intersections on either residential or commercial zoned land, to help guide tour visitors on the most direct route to the parade entry. Builders will be instructed to not place directional arrows in the right-of-way and to attain permission from property owners if the directional arrows are placed off site.

There are 22 entries on the Fall Parade of Homes, all in Lawrence. The purpose of our tour is to highlight the latest in home building features and trends and to give the community a composite of the types of newly built homes available in Lawrence and surrounding areas.
