### B. CONSENT AGENDA:

**Moved by Commissioner Larsen, seconded by Vice Mayor Soden**, to approve Traffic Calming Projects for 2016 construction; and, direct staff to review the Ousdahl Road plan to determine if additional recommendations should be considered. Motion carried unanimously.
