Lawrence Public Library staff concur with the findings of 360 Energy Engineers regarding needed energy-saving and maintenance upgrades to the Lawrence Public Library. These energy saving upgrades include weatherization measures for the building, LED lighting retrofits, and optimization of the existing building controls system. The total cost for these measures is \$65,936.

The Library staff and Board recognize the advantages and cost efficiencies of partnering with the City's FCIP project to achieve these energy and maintenance saving projects.

Therefore, Lawrence Public Library agrees to enter into a contract with the City of Lawrence to participate in the financing for the Library project as part of the FCIP program, and will pay the City \$65,936 to cover the Library's portion of the FCIP project.
