- Originally established as the United States Indian Industrial WHEREAS: Training School in 1884 as a boarding school, and evolving into a post high school, vocational-technical institution in 1935, Haskell began offering Junior college curriculum and became Haskell Indian Junior College in 1970; and
- WHEREAS: Haskell Indian Nations University was established in 1993, currently representing over 130 federally recognized tribes from throughout the United States; and
- WHEREAS: Haskell is a unique and diverse intertribal university committed to the advancement of sovereignty, selfdetermination, and the inherent rights of tribes; and
- WHEREAS: Haskell will hold its alumni homecoming events October 13 and 14, and its Lawrence community event, "Experience Haskell", on Saturday, October 14, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in recognition of Haskell's significance to Indigenous communities and in recognition of its place within and connection to the City of Lawrence; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Lawrence recognizes its long and historic relationship with indigenous peoples of Lawrence celebrated Indigenous People's Day on Monday, October 9.
