Narrative: The Outreach Team served a total of 149 individuals and families during the second quarter of 2017. These services resulted in assisting 35 individuals and 3 families with obtaining housing. There was a general increase in most categories. There were also several individuals who obtained housing, but were subsequently evicted in the same quarter. This quarterly report was completed before the implementation of further demographic information collection, as requested by the HIAC. Notable issues remain flex funds available for rental/deposit assistance. The Outreach Team also notes a

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decrease in number of known landlords who are willing to work with individuals with poor rental and legal histories who also have affordable units available, and therefore a greater need for dedicated housing specialist staffing who can focus primarily on approaching and networking with potential landlords to possible generate further housing resources.
