This office represents Champion Builders, L.L.C., the lowest responsible bidder for the above identified project. My client was verbally notified yesterday by the architect Mr. Jay Zimmerschied of Zimmerschied Architecture, Inc., of the city of Lawrence's decision or intent to issue the contract for the Remodel and Gut Project for Fire Station No. 1, to a higher bidder, which we believe to be in violation of K.S.A. §13-1017. Pursuant to K.S.A. §13-1017 the City of Lawrence is charged with the responsibility of awarding said contract to the lowest responsible bidder, whose bid does not exceed the City's estimate. On bid day, Champion Builders, L.L.C. was the lowest responsible bidder by \$90,000.00. The only reason provided or relayed to my client was that BA Green had more experience in historic work. Champion Builders, L.L.C. does not agree with this position, when the contract documents are reviewed in their entirety and when as the project bid documents clearly state this is a complete "gut" remodel project, with the only historic preservation requirement found in the Masonry Restoration Project Specification Section. See Zimmerschied Architecture Pre-Bid Conference Agenda and Project Specification Section 040120.

K.S.A. §13-1017 is intended to save public funds and to guard against favoritism, improvidence and corruption. Clearly Champion Builders, L.L.C. is more than qualified as a commercial builder in Kansas, and Champion Builders bid would save \$90,000.00 of public funds. It appears to Champion Builders, that favoritism for a local Lawrence contractor will cost the citizens of Lawrence an additional or wasted \$90,000.00. Please review the following attached information, so the Lawrence City Council performs its duty to save public funds as set forth in K.S.A. §13-1017.
