



- Written Testimony
 - No more than 4 pages
 - List affiliation and contact information
 - Date of meeting for testimony
 - Email testimony to KLRD staff per schedule
 - Bring 70 copies to Task Force Meetings



- Oral Testimony
 - No more than 10 minutes
 - Notify KLRD staff ahead of time if you have a multimedia presentation
 - All testimony becomes public record
