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

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# Task Force – Tips to Testify

- Written Testimony
  - No more than 4 pages
  - List affiliation and contact information
  - Date of meeting for testimony
  - Email testimony to KLRD staff per schedule
  - Bring 70 copies to Task Force Meetings

# Task Force – Tips to Testify

- Oral Testimony
  - No more than 10 minutes
  - Notify KLRD staff ahead of time if you have a multi-media presentation
  - All testimony becomes public record

- Past projects with identifiable economic development because of transportation efforts
- Unfunded projects
- Safety concerns
- Projects with opportunity for coordination/pooled funding mechanisms
- Expected benefits of any projects to your community

- What program categories would be most helpful to local governments' needs and concerns?
  - Special City-County Highway Fund
  - Connecting Link
  - Loan Programs
- Keep it simple and impactful
- Be available during breaks of the committee to visit with members, answer questions they might have.

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## Webinar Archives



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The League provides multiple educational opportunities to city elected and appointed leaders each year. As part of our ongoing efforts to expand educational opportunities, members now have access to our video resources. Our webinars are conveniently categorized below for ease of access.

### League-Presented Webinars:

The League offers webinars generally on a monthly basis to members for a nominal fee. Sixty days after the live webinar takes place, the League will post video links of archived webinars for members as a resource. The cost for re-broadcast of a webinar is \$15 per webinar, \$25 for non-members. Municipal Training Institute credit will only be granted if participating in the live broadcast, and not for a re-broadcast.
